**Year 8 AIMS:** Students will be able to identify personal skills and strengths in preparation for employment.  
Students will be able to explore life skills through the Ambassador Award.

**SCOPE and careers focused lessons in Autumn and Spring term**

- Personal skills and strengths including team work activities.
- Period one activities including the Ambassador Award from SLQ.
