

What do I need to bring into school?

Frequently Asked Questions

As part of your daily routine, you should organise everything you are going to need for your school day. This includes:

1. Correct school uniform
2. Additional kit such as for P.E
3. Any correspondence with parents and carers such as letters to be returned, absence notes, uniform notes etc
4. Food and refreshments or money to purchase from the canteen, unless you are FSM
5. Sometimes you might be asked to bring something in for a specific subject, such as ingredients for your Food Technology lessons
6. Homework
7. Equipment for Learning

You are expected to bring in the basic equipment everyday which includes a school bag, pen, pencil and ruler.



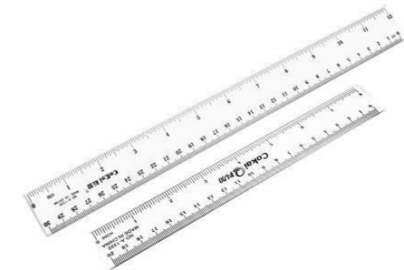
Strong school bag

Black or blue pen for writing



15cm or 30cm ruler for measuring and underlining

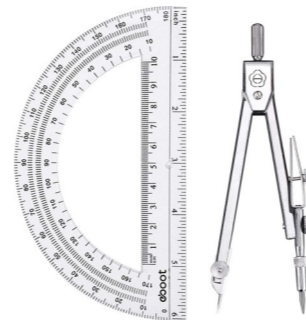
It is always advisable though to be as well prepared as possible, so you may find having the following items useful:



Alternative colour pens such as green and purple



Sharpener and rubber



Protractor and compass



OR a Maths set



Scientific calculator



Reading Book



Highlighters



Coloured pencils
