Dear Parents and Carers,

This morning we were made aware of two members of our school community who have tested positive for COVID-19.

The first case is within year 7 and following a risk assessment, completed with PHE, students who have been identified as being a contact of the affected individual have already been told to self-isolate.

The second case is within year 12 and in this instance the risk assessment was that the whole of year 12 should isolate. They have now switched to remote provision for the rest of this term.

All other students should continue to attend school as normal if they are well.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least **10 days** from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test or by calling 119.
